



BY-LAW 78-16

of the

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a By-Law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge
to amend the Cambridge Farmers' Market By-Law 161-09.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 113 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, Council may pass by-laws for establishing, maintaining and operating markets and for regulating such markets and any other markets located within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge has enacted By-Law 161-09 as the Cambridge Farmers' Market By-Law;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge deems it expedient to amend By-Law 161-09 as a result of housekeeping amendments;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw 161 – 09 is amended as follows:

a.) "Commissioner" is replaced with "Deputy City Manager for the Community Services Department or designate"

b.) By adding a new section 8.1 which reads as follows:

The Market shall be exempt from the Outdoor Vendor By-Law 106

b.) Sections 38 through 41 inclusive are deleted be deleted.

2. c.) Section 43 is deleted and replaced as follows:

43. Parties interested in using the performance areas shall obtain a permit specific to the Cambridge Farmers' Market from the Market Manager.

3. d.) Section 47 is deleted and replaced as follow:

47. Busking will be permitted outside of market hours as long as performers have a current permit for busking with the City of Cambridge and follow the rules and regulations under By-Law 78-15.

4. THAT this By-Law shall come into full force and effect on the date of final passing thereof.
